

Area: Warman, Saskatchewan, Canada 8.0467 kilometer ring

Benchmark: Canada



Population

The population in Warman, Saskatchewan, Canada 8.0467 kilometer ring is estimated to change from 17,475 to 20,462, resulting in a growth of 17.1% between the year 2011 and the current year. Over the next five years, the population is projected to grow by 21.7%.

The current year median age for this population is 31.8.

The population in Canada is estimated to change from 34,246,075 to 35,567,104, resulting in a growth of 3.9% between the year 2011 and the current year. Over the next five years, the population is expected to grow by 6.5%

The current year median age for Canada is 40.2.



Household

The number of households in this area is estimated to change from 5,859 to 6,995, resulting in an increase of 19.4% between 2011 and the current year.

Of the 6,161 families in the area, 5,563 are married or common law couples and 598 are single-parent families.

There are on average 0.7 children per family.

The number of households in Canada is estimated to change from 13,588,165 to 14,262,277, resulting in an increase of 5.0% between 2011 and the current year.

Of the 10,331,768 families in the area, 8,486,814 are married or common law couples and 1,844,954 are single-parent families.

There are on average 0.6 children per family.
